Learning objectives:

- Introduction to the study of the Portuguese language through the acquisition of basic linguistic skills to the phonetic level, morphological, syntactic and grammatical.
- Develop the learner, basic communication skills that allow you to interact with a minimum of success in everyday situations, linking them to cultural characteristics of the Portuguese.
- Allow the acquisition of knowledge as much as possible extended the country, the reality of Culture and values; Portuguese and Portugal in the European Context.
