One the other hand, the event was to provide a glance at the business world, for all the new students.



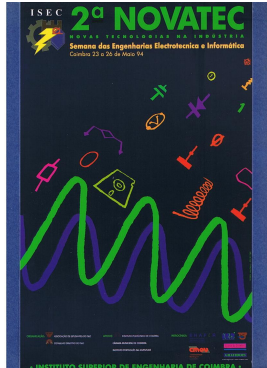

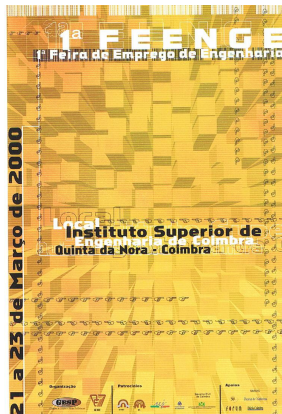

In a different perspective, there is also the purpose of adapting the curricular programmes of ISEC to the needs of the industry, in terms of engineering and management.

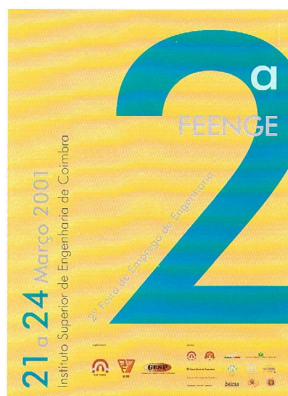
